






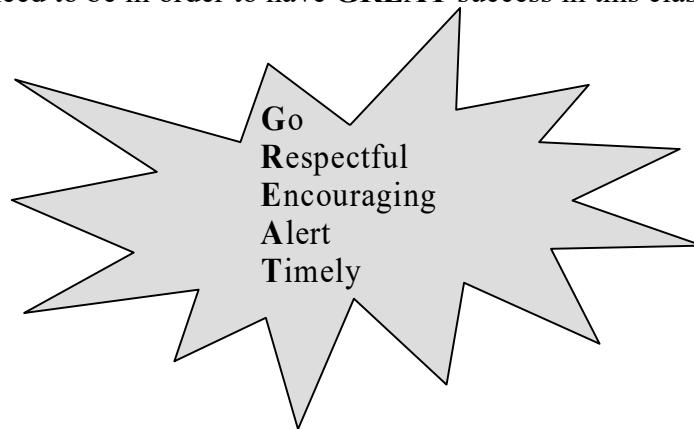
**Class participation:**
